Under the CARES act, our institutions have been allocated \$21,213.00 to grant to students as emergency grant aid to be used for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus, including eligible expenses under a student's cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care.

Our institution retains discretion to determine the amount of each individual emergency financial aid grant consistent with all applicable laws including non-discrimination laws. To expedite the process of distributing the emergency grants to students, and to be as equitable as possible, we will calculate and distribute the grants as follows:
